

Biography of Mr Salem Omar

Salem Omar was born in Alami and describes himself as a proud Gratifacian. He has vivid memories of playing football on the streets of Naa'moura and in the fields near to what was later to become the National Football Centre.

Mr Omar is a 35 year old MBA graduate of the American University of Cairo where he specialised in innovation. His first role after leaving University was to work as an intern for the French Embassy in Cairo in the Diplomatic section. He then moved to work for the French Ministry of Sport in Paris.
